Applications

Deadlines

Round 1: October 15, 2011 / Round 2: January 15, 2012 / Round 3: April 15, 2012

Please note that historically, a majority of merit-based scholarships are awarded to applicants meeting the early deadlines.

The following items are required for your application to any school of business graduate program:

1. David Eccles School of Business online application (www.business.utah.edu/mastersapplication)
2. GMAT/GRE official test score
3. For international students only, a TOEFL score is required. The Eccles School of Business requires a minimum score of 600 pbt or 100 ibt / IELTS minimum score is 7.0. Please note that these are higher scores than required by the University of Utah graduate school. For more information, visit www.sa.utah.edu/admiss/InterGrad.htm.

What to expect from the David Eccles School of Business online application

- Personal Information – name, address, social security number, date of birth, etc.
- Professional Resume – you will need to upload your resume
- Essays – essay requirements will be detailed within the online application. You will be asked to upload your essays. (Word document format)
- Unofficial Transcripts – you will be asked to upload your unofficial transcripts from all undergraduate institutions. The university requires an undergraduate degree from an accredited institution and a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0. If your GPA does not meet this standard, the GPA from your last 60 hours is accepted.
- Residency determination – you will be asked questions to determine your residency status
- Application Fee – the application fee is \$55 for domestic applicants and \$65 for international applicants
- Recommendations – 2 recommendations are required for all programs unless waived for fast track applications. You will need to supply the email addresses for the individuals submitting your recommendations for this online process. All recommendations must be submitted online. Paper recommendations will not be accepted.

Tuition / Costs

Total Program Cost: Resident \$42,000 (Non-residents should contact our admissions coordinator for more information about non-resident tuition.)

- These estimates reflect 62 total credit hours taken over the course of 4 semesters at the current tuition rates. Please note that this is an estimate and tuition rates may increase without notice over the next academic year.
- Merit-based scholarships / Graduate Assistantships are available to MBA students. Students seeking scholarships are encouraged to get application materials submitted as early as possible. On average, 30% of our MBA students receive financial assistance.
- Financial aid in the form of loans is available to domestic graduate students. Please contact the University financial aid office at www.sa.utah.edu/finance.
